Lens type (I.e.: Auto Iris, Varifocal or Fixed)

Recording Equipement

Storage period (I.e.: 1 week, 3 months, 12 months...)

Recording speed (I.e.: 0.5ips, 5ips, 100ips...)

Archiving/access facilities (I.e.: Network accessible, USB thumb drive, CD-RW, external devices required...)
